
All maps are IOF standards, status: 2025. Maps will be printed on waterproof paper.

Transportation to the competition area

Transportation to the competition area will be provided by the organizer. Bus station GPS: 49.9729422N, 12.7035208E, <u>navigation link</u>

It is **NOT allowed** to use own transportation to start and finish areas of any WYAC **classic** competitions. Spectators **must use** the transportation together with competitors and get on bus number 2.

Traffic by own vehicles to the **sprint** finish area **is allowed**.



Transmitters and antennas

3.5 MHz transmitters (classic)

- CONTEST2020, RF power: 3 W, A1A modulation
- Antenna: 8m vertical + 8 m single radial counterpoise
- Frequency:
 - TX 1-5 (MOE-MO5): 3.53 MHz
 - 1 min transmitting, 4 mins space
 - finish beacon (MO): 3.60 MHz
 - continuous operation

144 MHz transmitters (classic)

- CONTEST2020, RF power: 3 W PEP, A2A modulation (1 kHz, 80% AM)
- Antenna: crossed dipoles 3 m above the terrain
- Frequency:
 - TX 1-5 (MOE-MO5): 144.50 MHz
 - 1 min transmitting, 4 mins space
 - finish beacon (MO): 144.85 MHz
 - continuous operation

3.5 MHz transmitters for sprint

- CONTEST2020, RF power: 1 W, A1A modulation
- Antenna: 8m vertical + 8 m single radial counterpoise formed in the circle around the transmitter
- Frequency:
 - TX 1-5 (MOE-MO5): 3.53 MHz
 - keying speed: 50 PARIS
 - 12 sec transmitting, 48 sec space
 - Spectators control (S): 3.55 MHz
 - keying speed: 50 PARIS
 - continuous operation
 - TX 1F-5F (MOE-MO5): 3.57 MHz
 - keying speed: 70 PARIS
 - 12 sec transmitting, 48 sec space
 - Finish beacon (MO): 3.60 MHz
 - keying speed: 50 PARIS
 - continuous operation

Technical information

• Flags

3.5 MHz and 144 MHz classics

Standard 30x30 cm 3-sided white and orange flags at all controls

Sprint

30x30 cm 3-sided white and orange flags at S (spectator) and B (beacon) controls, red/white striped SI stands (no flag) at all other controls.

• Registering devices

SportIdent at all controls (NOT in the AIR mode) with control numbers written on the SI units.



Notes

Thunderstorm

In a case of a severe thunderstorm, the Chairman of the Jury may recall the competition (ARDF Rules B 27.5).

In such case, it will be announced to competitors b by switching off all transmitters except for the beacon and TX No.1 (MOE, not necessarily the one placed in terrain) which both remain operating continuously. The competitors shall set for the finish immediately.

• GPS devices

The use of satellite positioning devices is allowed provided they do not contain digital map of the terrain.

• Insurance and Medical Care

First aid facility will be available at the finish areas for all competitions. No cost to the participant applies for on-site minor treatment; however, the cost for ambulance transportation, emergency department visits, and clinic visits will be the participant's responsibility. Thus, we recommend you purchasing an insurance covering such expenses.

• Anti-doping

Every competitor is obliged to undergo an anti-doping check upon request!



It is only allowed to use official transportation to start and finish, usage of own vehicles is **forbidden!** Transportation of team officals from start to finish area will be provided. The distance from the bus stop to the start area is a 10-minutes walk.

The receivers, including spare ones (all marked with stickers), will be handed over just after reaching start area. It will be organized separately country by country. Spare receivers (clearly indicating the team) will be collected and placed at the starting line.

In the pre-start area, competitors may prepare their maps on tables, scotch tape and scissors will be provided.

Start, beacon, finish, finish corridor, 400 m and 500 m circles **ARE** preprinted in purple on the maps.



Start organisation

Competitors will be called to pre-start area 15 min before their starts!



Finish organisation

Finish corridor is 260 m long, marked with red-white ribbons and tape. The marking of the corridor is one sided, last 50 m two-sided.



- C 120 m one-sided, marked with red-white ribbons and tape


Start organisation

Competitors will be called to pre-start area 15 min before their starts!



Finish organisation

Finish corridor is 135 m long, double-sided, marked with red-white tape. Before entering the meadow, competitors **need to jump** over a **small ditch** (will be marked).

It is only allowed to use official transportation to start, usage of own vehicles is **forbidden!**

Transportation of team officals from start to finish area will be provided. Traffic by own vehicles to the sprint finish area **is allowed**.

The receivers, including spare ones (all marked with stickers), will be handed over just after reaching start area. It will be organized separately country by country. Spare receivers (clearly indicating the team) will be collected and placed at the starting line.

In the pre-start area, competitors may prepare their maps on tables, scotch tape and scissors will be provided.

Start, spectator control (S), beacon, finish and finish corridor **ARE** pre-printed in purple on the maps.

Starting interval is 3 minutes. However, some categories will be shifted by one minute - see the starting list.






